## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 58

February 13, 2007 – Introduced by Representatives Albers, Hahn, Owens, Ballweg and Kaufert, cosponsored by Senator Schultz. Referred to Committee on Corrections and Courts.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 753.06 (6) (e) of the statutes; relating to: adding a circuit court
- 2 branch in Juneau County.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, Juneau County has one circuit court branch. As of August 1, 2008, this bill adds one circuit court branch in Juneau County.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 753.06 (6) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 753.06 (6) (e) Juneau County. The circuit has one branch. <u>Commencing August</u>
5 <u>1, 2008, the circuit has 2 branches.</u>
6 SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions; circuit courts.

- 7 (1) The initial election for circuit judge for branch 2 of the circuit court for
- 8 Juneau County shall be at the spring election of 2008 for terms commencing August
- 9 1, 2008, and ending July 31, 2014.

(2) The authorized FTE positions for the circuit courts are increased by 1.0 GPR
 circuit judge position on June 30, 2008, to be funded from the appropriation under
 section 20.625 (1) (a) of the statutes, to provide an additional circuit court judge for
 the circuit court branch created by this act.

(3) The authorized FTE positions for the circuit courts are increased by 1.0 GPR
court reporter position on June 30, 2008, to be funded from the appropriation under
section 20.625 (1) (a) of the statutes, to provide one court reporter for the circuit court
branch created by this act.
