Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the uniform fees charged for technical college collegiate transfer courses from at least 31 percent of statewide average operational costs for such programs to at least 42 percent in 2009–10 and to at least 50 percent in 2010–11 and thereafter. Collegiate transfer programs are offered at the Chippewa Valley, Madison, Milwaukee, and Nicolet technical colleges.

3. In the $2010-11$ school year and in each school year thereafter, 50 percent.
