## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 798

February 13, 2008 – Introduced by Representatives Kerkman, Kreuser, Turner, Mursau, Nass, Molepske and Gunderson, cosponsored by Senators Wirch, Olsen and Grothman. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

- AN ACT to renumber and amend 563.93 (4); and to create 563.93 (4) (b) of the
- 2 statutes; **relating to:** the sale of raffle tickets.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, certain religious, charitable, service, fraternal, veterans, and not-for-profit organizations may conduct a raffle upon obtaining a raffle license. An organization conducting a raffle may not sell tickets for the raffle more than 270 days before the raffle drawing.

This bill provides that an organization that holds a raffle license and has been in existence for at least five years may sell raffle tickets up to one year before the raffle drawing.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **SECTION 1.** 563.93 (4) of the statutes is renumbered 563.93 (4) (a) and amended to read:
- 5 563.93 (4) (a) Tickets Except as provided in par. (b), tickets for a proposed raffle
- 6 may not be offered for sale more than 270 days before the raffle drawing.
