## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 923

- 1 AN ACT to create 973.075 (1) (b) 1m. h. of the statutes; relating to: forfeiture
- 2 of a vehicle used to transport a corpse.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person's vehicle may be seized and forfeited if the person used the vehicle in the commission of certain crimes. This bill allows a person's vehicle to be seized and forfeited if the person used the vehicle to transport a corpse with the intent to conceal a crime or avoid apprehension, prosecution, or conviction for a crime.

- **SECTION 1.** 973.075 (1) (b) 1m. h. of the statutes is created to read:
- 973.075 (1) (b) 1m. h. To transport a corpse with the intent to conceal a crime or avoid apprehension, prosecution, or conviction for a crime, or in the commission of a crime under s. 940.11 (1) or (2).
