2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 937

March 11, 2008 - Introduced by Representative Molepske. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

AN ACT to amend 346.95 (1); and to create 346.94 (20) of the statutes; relating 1

to: school bus seating positions and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a person from operating a school bus if any child is seated in a seating position in the rearmost two rows of the school bus, unless all seating positions except those in the rearmost two rows are occupied. A person who violates this prohibition may be required to forfeit not less than \$20 nor more than \$40 for the first offense and not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for the second or subsequent conviction within one year.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 346.94 (20) of the statutes is created to read:
- 346.94 (20) School bus seating positions. (a) Except as provided in par. (b), no person may operate a school bus if any child is seated in a seating position in the 6 rearmost 2 rows of the school bus.
 - (b) If all seating positions in all rows except the rearmost 2 rows of the school bus are occupied, any child may be seated in a seating position in the 2nd to the

1	rearmost row until all seating positions in that row are occupied, and then any child
2	may be seated in a seating position in the rearmost row of the school bus.
3	Section 2. 346.95 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	346.95 (1) Any person violating s. 346.87, 346.88, 346.89 (2), 346.90 to 346.92,
5	or $346.94(1), (9), (10), (11), (12)$ or, (15) , or (20) may be required to forfeit not less than
6	\$20 nor more than $$40$ for the first offense and not less than $$50$ nor more than $$100$
7	for the 2nd or subsequent conviction within a year.
8	SECTION 3. Initial applicability.
9	(1) This act first applies to vehicles operated on the effective date of this
10	subsection.
11	Section 4. Effective date.
