## **2007 SENATE BILL 79**

March 1, 2007 – Introduced by Senator Lassa, cosponsored by Representatives Vruwink, Albers and Gronemus. Referred to Committee on Small Business, Emergency Preparedness, Workforce Development, Technical Colleges and Consumer Protection.

- 1 AN ACT to create 100.55 of the statutes; relating to: the sale and distribution
- 2 of elastic yo-yos and providing a penalty.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the sale or distribution of an elastic yo-yo, defined in the bill as any toy known as a "yo-yo waterball" or any other similar toy consisting of a rubber-like object that is attached to an elastic cord.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report concerning the proposed penalty and the costs or savings that are likely to result if the bill is enacted.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 100.55 of the statutes is created to read:
- 100.55 Sale and distribution of elastic yo-yos prohibited. (1) In this section, "elastic yo-yo" means any toy known as a "yo-yo waterball" or any similar toy consisting of a rubber-like object that is attached to an elastic cord.
  - (2) No person may sell or distribute an elastic yo-yo to a person in this state.

(3) A person who violates sub. (2) may be fined not more than \$1,000. Each sale or distribution of an elastic yo-yo is a separate violation.
