



## 2007 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 58

August 22, 2007 – Introduced by Senator OLSEN, cosponsored by Representative BALLWEG. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **Relating to:** Badger Mining Corporation of Berlin, Wisconsin.
