3 Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America incorporated February 8, 1910, at Chicago,
4 Illinois, by publisher William D. Boyce; and

5 Whereas, the United States Congress recognized the value of the Boy Scouts of
6 America by issuing a federal charter June 15, 1916; and

7 Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America celebrate over 98 years of existence in the
8 United States; and

9 Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America mission is to prepare young people to make
10 ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling the values of the Scout
11 Oath and Law; and

12 Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America make a direct and positive impact on
13 communities by teaching the principles of American social, economic, and
14 governmental systems, along with the values that encourage leadership; and
