April 2, 2010 – Introduced by Representatives KESTELL, VAN AKKEREN and LEMAHIEU, cosponsored by Senators LEIBHAM and GROTHMAN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

6	his education at Marquette University; and
7	Whereas, Mr. Ireland served honorably in the United States Air Force during
8	World War II; and
9	Whereas, Mr. Ireland was united in marriage to Mable F. Spatzek of Sheboygan
10	on December 28, 1946, and the couple was later blessed with the birth of their
11	daughter, Sandra; and
12	Whereas, Mr. Ireland served in the Wisconsin state assembly from 1958 to

10 insurance agent until his retirement in 1986; and	
11 Whereas, Mr. Ireland was passionate about his faith, family, community,	and
12 politics, and also enjoyed fishing, hunting, bowling, and watching the Milway	ukee
13 Brewers; and	
14 Whereas, Mr. Ireland also served as secretary of the Kohler Fire Departm	nent
15 for 45 years, was a member of the Kohler Police Athletic League, and was a	ı life
16 member of American Legion Post 83; and	
17 Whereas, Mr. Ireland served with principle and integrity, and his legacy	will
18 surely serve as an inspiration for those whose lives he touched; now, therefore,	be it
