5	High School in 1932; and
6	Whereas, John A. Volk married Alice Sickler in 1940; and
7	Whereas, John A. Volk served on the Freedom Town Board and Forest County
8	Board in the late 1940s and on the Wabeno School Board from 1952 to 1975; and
9	Whereas, John A. Volk was elected to the Wisconsin assembly in a special
10	election in June of 1983, serving in the 1983 through 1989 sessions; and
11	Whereas, during his tenure in the legislature, Mr. Volk was chair of the Rural
12	Development and Forestry Committee in the 1989 session, vice-chair of the
13	Education Committee in the 1985 session, and co-chair of the Joint Survey
14	Committee on Retirement Systems in the 1985 and 1989 sessions; now, therefore, be
