

## **2009 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 85**

October 21, 2009 – Introduced by Representatives Hixson, Sheridan, Benedict, JORGENSEN, VRUWINK, TURNER, BERCEAU and TOWNSEND, cosponsored by Senators ROBSON, MILLER, OLSEN, TAYLOR and SCHULTZ. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	<b>Relating to:</b> recognizing the work of Wisconsin's coroners and medical examiners.
2	Whereas, Wisconsin's coroners and medical examiners provide medicolegal
3	death investigations in each of our 72 counties; and
4	Whereas, approximately 375 professionals currently serve our citizens as
5	coroners, medical examiners, deputies, and death investigators; and
6	Whereas, these dedicated public servants perform their duties for all citizens
7	and guests of our state, day and night, 365 days per year; and
8	Whereas, they work closely with the justice system and public health and safety
9	agencies using the tools of forensic science and medicine; and
10	Whereas, they work closely with the families and friends of those who have
11	died, offering compassion and understanding during a time of grief and loss; and
12	Whereas, they work to understand and explain the cause and circumstances of
13	unexpected, unusual, and suspicious deaths for the benefit of our communities; and
14	Whereas, they are dedicated professionals performing a duty and service
15	worthy of respect and recognition; now, therefore, be it

1	<b>Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That</b> the fourth week of
2	October be annually recognized as Medicolegal Death Investigators Week, with the
3	gratitude of the people of the state of Wisconsin for the service that they provide.
