## 2009 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 41

June 16, 2009 – Introduced by Senator DECKER, cosponsored by Representative SHERIDAN. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **Relating to:** creating a committee of conference on 2009 Assembly Bill 75, the  
2             executive budget bill of the 2009 legislature.

3             *Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*, upon the adoption  
4     of this joint resolution by the senate and concurrence therein by the assembly and  
5     notwithstanding joint rule 3, there is created a committee of conference on 2009  
6     Assembly Bill 75, relating to state finances and appropriations, constituting the  
7     executive budget bill of the 2009 legislature, to reconcile the differences between the  
8     2 houses and to present its report on the bill to the 2 houses; and

9             *Be it further resolved, That*, notwithstanding joint rule 3 (1), senate rule  
10    20m, and assembly rule 3 (1) (j):

11            (1) The committee of conference on 2009 Assembly Bill 75 shall consist of 4  
12    members from each house, with 3 members from each house representing the  
13    majority party in that house and one member from each house representing the  
14    minority party in that house.

1           (2) (a) The senate members of the committee of conference on 2009 Assembly  
2 Bill 75 representing the majority party shall be appointed by the president of the  
3 senate and the senate member representing the minority party shall be appointed  
4 by the senate minority leader.

5           (b) The assembly members of the committee of conference on 2009 Assembly  
6 Bill 75 representing the majority party shall be appointed by the speaker of the  
7 assembly and the assembly member representing the minority party shall be  
8 appointed by the assembly minority leader.

9           (3) The report by the committee of conference on 2009 Assembly Bill 75 must  
10 be supported by the votes of at least 3 of the 4 members representing each house.
