



2009 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 66

April 9, 2010 – Introduced by Senator LASSA, cosponsored by Representative MOLEPSKE JR.. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** proclaiming May 5, 2010, as Undergraduate Research Day and
2 commending University of Wisconsin System students, faculty, and staff.

3 Whereas, the University of Wisconsin (UW) System is one of the nation's
4 foremost public university systems with 13 four-year universities, 13 two-year
5 colleges, a statewide UW-Extension, and more than 178,000 students and 32,000
6 employees; and

7 Whereas, at each of the UW System institutions, undergraduate researchers
8 are advancing the tradition of the Wisconsin Idea as they join with faculty mentors
9 in discovering and applying new ideas to improve the quality of life in our state; and

10 Whereas, cutting-edge research and development conducted at UW System
11 institutions is vital to Wisconsin's economic development and the creation of new
12 jobs; and

13 Whereas, on Wednesday, May 5, the UW System will host the seventh annual
14 "Posters in the Rotunda: A Celebration of Undergraduate Research" at the Wisconsin

1 state capitol, featuring research projects presented by undergraduate students from
2 across the system; and

3 Whereas, the posters represent a wide array of academic disciplines and
4 illustrate the remarkable contributions made by our undergraduate students to
5 address issues of critical importance to Wisconsin and to our nation; and

6 Whereas, the undergraduate research projects featured during “Posters in the
7 Rotunda” exemplify the innovation and entrepreneurship necessary for the
8 development and continued growth of our communities, state, and nation; now,
9 therefore, be it

10 ***Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*** the Wisconsin
11 legislature proclaims May 5, 2010, as Undergraduate Research Day and commends
12 the University of Wisconsin System students, faculty, and staff for their
13 undergraduate research efforts.
