## **2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 735**

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the governor's salary is set at 21.6 percent above the minimum of the salary range for Executive Salary Group 10, as established in the state civil service compensation plan. This bill sets the governor's salary at 300 percent of the mean annual salary for all occupations in Wisconsin, as determined by the Bureau of Labor Standards in the federal Department of Labor.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.923 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
20.923 (2) (c) The annual salary of the governor shall be set at 21.6% above the
minimum of the salary range for executive salary group 10 300 percent of the mean
annual salary for all occupations in Wisconsin, as determined by the bureau of labor
statistics in the federal department of labor.

## **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**
