## 2011 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 108

2 Whereas, Green Bay Packers quarterback Aaron Rodgers is the best 3 quarterback playing in the National Football League and wears jersey #12; and Whereas, Aaron Rodgers in just a few years as a starter has established himself 4 as a great leader of the Green Bay Packers and confidently takes the trust his 5 6 teammates and coaches have placed in him to lead his team to further greatness; and 7 Whereas, Aaron Rodgers was named Most Valuable Player of Super Bowl XLV; 8 and 9 Whereas, Aaron Rodgers was named Most Valuable Player of the 2011 season, 10 winning 48 out of 50 possible votes; and 11 Whereas, Aaron Rodgers led the Green Bay Packers on a 19-game winning 12 streak between the 2010 and 2011 seasons; and

Whereas, Aaron Rodgers became the only player in NFL history to throw for over 4,000 yards in each of the first two seasons as a starting quarterback; and

1	Whereas, Aaron Rodgers played the best season of his career in 2011, throwing
2	for 4,643 yards, 45 touchdowns, and just 6 interceptions, good for a passer rating of
3	122.5, which is now the best single-season passer rating in NFL history; and
4	Whereas, Aaron Rodgers earned the National Football Conference Offensive
5	Player of the Month award for September, October, and November, and FedEx Air
6	Player of the Week six times (Weeks 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, and 13); and
7	Whereas, Aaron Rodgers currently holds the record for all-time consecutive
8	games with at least two touchdown passes at 13; and
9	Whereas, Aaron Rodgers' performance on November 24, 2011, during the
10	annual Thanksgiving Day Classic earned him the coveted Galloping Gobbler Most
11	Valuable Player award; and
12	Whereas, the Green Bay Packers finished the 2011 regular season at the top of
13	their division with a record of 15-1, thanks in large part to Aaron Rodgers; and
14	Whereas, Aaron Rodgers is actively involved in the charitable organization
15	Midwest Athletes Against Childhood Cancer (the MACC Fund); now, therefore, be

17	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That in appreciation of
18	Aaron Rodgers' athletic accomplishments and humanitarian activities, the
19	Wisconsin legislature hereby commends Aaron Rodgers on his accomplishments and
20	declares that December 12, 2012, is proclaimed "Aaron Rodgers Day" in Wisconsin;

22	Resolved, That the assembly chief clerk shall transmit a copy of this joint
23	resolution to Aaron Rodgers.
