## **2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 305**

August 23, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives SMITH, WRIGHT, DANOU, GOYKE, BERNARD SCHABER, SHANKLAND, SINICKI, BERCEAU, WACHS, CLARK, JORGENSEN, OHNSTAD, HEBL and MILROY. Referred to Joint Committee on Finance.

1 AN ACT to create 20.115 (4) (s) and 93.60 of the statutes; relating to: grazing

lands conservation grants and making an appropriation.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The 2013–15 biennial budget act, 2013 Wisconsin Act 20, eliminated statutory authority for the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection to award grants for technical education and research under the Wisconsin Grazing Lands Conservation Initiative. The purpose of the initiative is to maintain and improve the management and productivity of grazing lands.

This bill restores statutory authority for grants for technical education and research under the Wisconsin Grazing Lands Conservation Initiative and provides funding for the grants.
