2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 535

November 25, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives Craig, Schraa, Kessler, Ballweg, Bernier, Czaja, Jagler, Kahl, Knodl, Kuglitsch, T. Larson, Lemahieu, Loudenbeck, Murtha, Nass, Ohnstad, Pridemore, Sanfelippo, Swearingen and Vruwink, cosponsored by Senators Petrowski and Gudex. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

AN ACT to create 125.09 (7) of the statutes; relating to: prohibiting municipalities from providing alcohol beverages retailers with identification scanners.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits municipalities from providing to alcohol beverages retail licensees any device capable of scanning a driver's license or identification card issued by the Department of Transportation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 125.09 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

125.09 (7) MUNICIPALITY PROVIDING IDENTIFICATION SCANNERS. No municipality may provide, to any retail licensee under this chapter, any device capable of scanning an official identification card, as defined in s. 125.085 (1) (a) and (b).
