Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution calls for an advisory referendum on the question of whether the legislature should adopt a nonpartisan system for redistricting of legislative and congressional districts in this state. The referendum would be held at the 2014 general election.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That: the following
question be submitted, for advisory purposes only, to the voters of this state at the
2014 general election: **QUESTION 1:** Nonpartisan redistricting system. "Do you favor adoption of
a nonpartisan system for redistricting of legislative and congressional districts in
this state?"
