2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 522

November 13, 2015 – Introduced by Representatives STEFFEN, BERNIER, BORN, E. BROOKS, R. BROOKS, CONSIDINE, CZAJA, EDMING, GENRICH, JACQUE, KRUG, MACCO, NOVAK, A. OTT, PETRYK, SWEARINGEN, THIESFELDT and MURPHY, cosponsored by Senators MARKLEIN, GUDEX, MOULTON, OLSEN, RINGHAND, VINEHOUT and WIRCH. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

1	AN ACT to renumber and amend 304.074 (2); to amend 20.410 (1) (gf) and
2	302.33 (2) (a) 3.; and <i>to create</i> 20.410 (1) (gg) and 304.074 (2) (b) of the statutes;
3	relating to: reimbursement of counties for probationers, parolees, and persons
4	on extended supervision who are placed with the county pending disposition of
5	revocation proceedings.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, each probationer, parolee, and person on extended supervision is charged a \$3 monthly fee to help reimburse each county for costs it incurred while holding an individual pending the disposition of a probation, parole, or extended supervision revocation proceeding. Under current law, counties are reimbursed at the rate of \$40 per person per day unless the amount allocated for reimbursement is insufficient in which case the Department of Corrections (DOC) must prorate the payments. Under this bill, the reimbursement rate remains the same but DOC must use first the proceeds from the new fee and then the account under current law and prorate the payments only if those amounts are insufficient.

1	SECTION 1. 20.410 (1) (gf) of the statutes is amended to read:
2	20.410(1)(gf) Probation, parole, and extended supervision. The amounts in the
3	schedule for probation, parole, and extended supervision. All moneys received from
4	vendors under s. 301.08 (1) (c) 4. and from fees charged under s. 304.074 (2) (a) shall
5	be credited to this appropriation account.
6	SECTION 2. 20.410 (1) (gg) of the statutes is created to read:
7	20.410 (1) (gg) Reimbursement to counties for probation, parole, and extended
8	supervision holds. All moneys received from fees under s. $304.074(2)(b)$ to partially
9	reimburse counties, as provided under s. 302.33 (2), for the maintenance of persons
10	who are placed in the county jail or other county facility, or in a tribal jail under s.
11	302.445, pending disposition of probation, parole, or extended supervision
12	revocation proceedings.
13	SECTION 3. 302.33 (2) (a) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:
14	302.33 (2) (a) 3. After verification by the department, it shall reimburse the
15	county or tribal governing body at a rate of \$36 per person per day prior to January
16	1, 1993, and \$40 per person per day thereafter , subject to the conditions in subds. 1.
17	and 2. <u>Any amount not paid under s. 20.410 (1) (gg) shall be paid under s. 20.410 (1)</u>
18	(\underline{bn}) . If the amount provided under s. 20.410 (1) (bn) for any fiscal year is insufficient
19	to provide complete <u>the balance of the</u> reimbursement at that rate, the department
20	shall prorate the payments under this subdivision to counties or tribal governing
21	bodies for that fiscal year. The department shall not reimburse a county or tribal
22	governing body unless that county or tribal governing body informs the department
23	of the amount of reimbursement to which it is entitled under this subsection no later
24	than September 1 of the fiscal year following the fiscal year for which reimbursement
25	is requested.

1	SECTION 4. 304.074 (2) of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act 55,
2	is renumbered 304.074 (2) (intro.) and amended to read:
3	304.074 (2) (intro.) The department shall charge <u>a reasonable fee as</u>
4	determined by the department to probationers, parolees, and persons on extended
5	supervision <u>the following fees:</u>
6	(a) A reasonable fee, as determined by the department, to partially reimburse
7	the department for the costs of providing supervision and services. The department
8	shall collect moneys for the fees charged under this subsection <u>paragraph</u> and credit
9	those moneys to the appropriation account under s. 20.410 (1) (gf).
10	SECTION 5. 304.074 (2) (b) of the statutes is created to read:
11	304.074 (2) (b) A monthly reimbursement fee of \$3 to partially reimburse
12	counties for costs as provided under s. 302.33 (2) (a). The department shall collect
13	moneys for the fees charged under this paragraph and credit those moneys to the
14	appropriation account under s. 20.410 (1) (gg).
15	SECTION 6. Effective date.
16	(1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 5th month beginning after
17	publication.
