

2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 526

- November 18, 2015 Introduced by Representatives KLEEFISCH, MILROY, E. BROOKS, EDMING, GANNON, KAHL, KOOYENGA, KREMER, T. LARSON, MASON, A. OTT, RIPP, SKOWRONSKI, STEFFEN, TITTL and ZAMARRIPA, cosponsored by Senators MOULTON, MILLER, OLSEN, LASSA, MARKLEIN and WIRCH. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage.
- 1 AN ACT *to repeal* 29.192 (5) of the statutes; **relating to:** the open season for
 - hunting raccoon.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill eliminates the requirement that the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) establishes the open season for hunting raccoon earlier for residents than for nonresidents.

Under current law, DNR issues resident and nonresident hunting licenses that authorize the hunting of raccoon. DNR is required to establish the open season for hunting raccoon two weeks earlier for persons with resident licenses than for persons with nonresident licenses. This bill eliminates that requirement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 SECTION 1. 29.192 (5) of the statutes is repealed.
