

2015 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 23

February 4, 2016 – Introduced by Representatives SARGENT, BERCEAU, ZEPNICK, C. TAYLOR, POPE, SINICKI, BROSTOFF, JOHNSON, SPREITZER and SUBECK. Referred to Committee on Assembly Organization.

1 **Relating to:** creation of a task force on gun safety technology.

2 **Resolved by the assembly, That** the committee on assembly organization 3 shall immediately appoint a task force on gun safety technology, consisting of an equal number of members of the majority and minority parties, to study and 4 5 recommend ways to implement and promote gun safety technology, "smart gun" 6 technology, and gun personalization technology in Wisconsin. Gun violence has 7 become a public health epidemic in Wisconsin, and this task force shall be charged 8 with the study of proper safety technologies while still recognizing certain 9 protections under the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution. This 10 task force shall deliver its findings to the assembly before January 1, 2017.
