



2015 SENATE BILL 186

June 2, 2015 – Introduced by Senators LASSA, WIRCH, CARPENTER, HANSEN, SHILLING, HARRIS DODD, L. TAYLOR and RINGHAND, cosponsored by Representatives HESSELBEIN, GOYKE, MILROY, SUBECK, OHNSTAD, WACHS, SINICKI, JOHNSON, POPE, ZAMARRIPA, BERCEAU, RIEMER, SPREITZER, HEBL, KOLSTE, KESSLER, BARCA and JORGENSEN. Referred to Committee on Transportation and Veterans Affairs.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 45.03 (13) (o); and *to create* 343.14 (2) (k) and 343.21 (1g) of
2 the statutes; **relating to:** waiving operator’s license fees for disabled veterans.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation must charge required fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a license authorizing operation of “Class D” vehicles, which are automobiles and most passenger vehicles, or “Class M” motor vehicles, which are motorcycles. This bill waives those fees for an applicant who is a veteran with a service-connected disability.
