2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 6

January 12, 2017 - Introduced by Representative Ott, by request of Department of Employee Trust Funds. Referred to Committee on Judiciary.

AN ACT to amend 40.05 (5) (a) of the statutes; relating to: the waiting period for the employer's share of income continuation insurance premiums for certain teachers employed by the University of Wisconsin System (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Employee Trust Funds).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System pays the gross premium for income continuation insurance coverage for teachers employed by UW System who have more than one year of state service, subject to a 130-day waiting period. This bill changes the waiting period from 130 days to 180 days.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 40.05 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.05 (5) (a) For teachers employed by the board of regents of the university, no contribution if the teacher has less than one year of state creditable service and

- an amount equal to the gross premium for coverage subject to a 130-day 180-day
- 2 waiting period if the teacher has one year or more of state creditable service.
