2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 694

November 29, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives Considine, Bowen, C. Taylor, Genrich, Hesselbein, Pope, Fields, Goyke, Zamarripa, Berceau, Subeck, Anderson, Billings, Sargent, Shankland, Kolste and Sinicki, cosponsored by Senators Erpenbach, Wirch, Johnson, Hansen and Vinehout. Referred to Committee on Corrections.

- AN ACT to create 302.389 of the statutes; relating to: reports of incidents
- 2 between inmates and prison employees and between inmates.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that any incident between an employee or officer at a prison and an inmate or between an inmate and another inmate is open to public inspection, except that the warden or superintendent of the prison may redact any personally identifying information.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 302.389 of the statutes is created to read:
- **302.389 Incident reports.** A report of an incident between an employee or officer at a prison and an inmate or between an inmate and another inmate is open to public inspection and copying under s. 19.35 (1), except that the warden or superintendent of the prison may redact any personally identifying information of the parties.
