2017 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 23

February 13, 2018 - Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES.

1 **Relating to:** establishing special orders of business for Thursday, February 15,
2 2018.

3 ***Resolved by the assembly, That:***

SECTION 1. Special order scheduled. The following proposals shall be
special orders of business on Thursday, February 15, 2018, at the times shown:

- (1) At 1:01 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 530, relating to: nutritional food pilot program under FoodShare and providing an exemption from rule-making procedures.
- (2) At 1:02 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 547, relating to: permitting and mitigation requirements for nonfederal and artificial wetlands and state assumption of the federal regulatory program governing the discharge of dredged or fill material into navigable waters.
- (3) At 1:03 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 599, relating to: determinations of navigability of a stream.
- (4) At 1:04 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 666, relating to: sexual contact with an animal and providing a criminal penalty.
- (5) At 1:05 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 676, relating to: classifying county jailers as protective occupation participants under the Wisconsin Retirement System and the treatment of county jailers under the Municipal Employment Relations Act.

- (6) At 1:06 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 710, relating to: criminal penalties for fraud in obtaining unemployment insurance benefits and providing a criminal penalty.
- (7) At 1:07 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 734, relating to: creating individual and corporate income and franchise tax deductions for tuition paid for apprenticeship programs.
- (8) At 1:08 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 737, relating to: increased maximum terms of imprisonment for domestic abuse repeaters and providing a criminal penalty.
- (9) At 1:09 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 789, relating to: exempting certain facilities from solid waste facility regulations.
- (10) At 1:10 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 818, relating to: various changes to condominium law and rights related to first mortgage security interests in condominium units.
- (11) At 1:11 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 820, relating to: the standard of proof required to effect a temporary or permanent closure of a sport shooting range based on an unsafe condition.
- (12) At 1:12 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 822, relating to: confidentiality of financial institution information maintained by the Department of Financial Institutions; periodic examinations of financial institutions; savings bank loan limitations; interest on residential mortgage loan escrow accounts; capital of state banks; security provided by public depositories; insurance company liquidation proceedings; and modifying an administrative rule of the Department of Workforce Development related to an exemption from overtime pay requirements for outside salespersons.
- (13) At 1:13 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 852, relating to: denial, suspension, and revocation of certain licenses related to motor vehicle dealers.
- (14) At 1:14 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 872, relating to: career and technical education incentive grants for school districts and completion awards for students and making an appropriation.
- (15) At 1:15 p.m., 2017 Assembly Bill 911, relating to: funding for the Southeastern Wisconsin Fox River Commission and making an appropriation.
- (16) At 1:16 p.m., 2017 Senate Bill 339, relating to: Huber release for probationers confined in a county jail or county house of correction for a probation violation.

SECTION 2. Twelve hour notice. Consideration of the special order of business established in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall occur at the time shown in that section or 12 hours after adoption of this resolution, whichever is later.
