Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, Department of Workforce Development may award an incentive grant to a school district in which students successfully completed certain industry-recognized certification programs approved by DWD. This bill increases the appropriation by \$3,500,000 in fiscal year 2019–20 and fiscal year 2020–21 to fund the incentive grants.
