May 9, 2019 – Introduced by Representative DITTRICH, cosponsored by Senator FITZGERALD. Referred to Committee on Rules.

8	only two years with Marshall High School, has commendably led the team to
9	back-to-back state champion victories for the first time since the 1976-1977

12	years, has overseen the athletic programs at Marshall High School and helped
13	develop a culture of high achieving students, both in sport and in academics; and

15	Ceraya Morel, and Bailey Neuberger, along with their teammates, Alayna Cramblit,

Anna Lutz, Mya Andrews, Mia Morel, Rain Held, Skyla Michalak, Sandra Assaba,
Laura Nickel, and Abby Ward have demonstrated their commendable abilities and
sportsmanship, especially during the past two seasons; and
