2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 1178

March 10, 2022 – Introduced by Representatives BOWEN, SHELTON and SINICKI. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 AN ACT to amend 341.15 (3) (intro.) of the statutes; relating to: penalties for

improper display of motor vehicle registration plates and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, with certain exceptions, a registration plate must be placed at the front and the back of a motor vehicle. Plates must be firmly affixed, displayed horizontally and conspicuously, and maintained so as to be legible and unobstructed. A person who operates a motor vehicle with a plate that violates any of these requirements may be required to forfeit not more than \$200. Under the bill, the maximum forfeiture remains not more than \$200 for a first offense, but increases to not more than \$400 for a second or subsequent offense.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 (1) This act first applies to violations committed on the effective date of this 2 subsection, but does not preclude the counting of other convictions as prior 3 convictions for purposes of sentencing by a court.
