## 2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 24

- January 29, 2021 Introduced by Representatives THIESFELDT, HORLACHER, BROOKS and SCHRAA, cosponsored by Senators JACQUE, STROEBEL, DARLING, KAPENGA, MARKLEIN, PETROWSKI, WANGGAARD, Felzkowski, TESTIN. WIMBERGER, STAFSHOLT, NASS, KOOYENGA, BALLWEG and BRADLEY. Referred to Committee on Constitution and Ethics.
- AN ACT to create 252.03 (2g) of the statutes; relating to: closure of and 1 2 forbidding gatherings in places of worship.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits local health officers from closing or forbidding gatherings in places of worship to control outbreaks and epidemics of the 2019 novel coronavirus. Currently, local health officers have the statutory authority to do what is reasonable and necessary for the prevention and suppression of disease and forbid public gatherings when necessary to control outbreaks or epidemics, among other public health powers.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **SECTION 1.** 252.03 (2g) of the statutes is created to read: 4 252.03 (2g) A local health officer may not order the closure of or forbid gatherings in places of worship to control outbreaks and epidemics of the 2019 novel 5 6 coronavirus. 7
