2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 845

January 10, 2022 – Introduced by Representatives ZIMMERMAN, DITTRICH, EDMING, KRUG, LOUDENBECK, ORTIZ-VELEZ and SCHRAA, cosponsored by Senators BALLWEG, COWLES, DARLING and JAGLER. Referred to Committee on Substance Abuse and Prevention.

1 AN ACT relating to: medication-assisted treatment expansion.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to request supplemental funding from the Joint Committee on Finance and, if funding is received, to award grants to develop or support entities that offer medication-assisted treatment for substance use. The DHS appropriations may be supplemented after JCF approves a request by DHS for the funding, and JCF is not required to find an emergency to make the supplement.
