This bill provides \$10,000,000 in grant funding in the 2021–23 fiscal biennium through the Department of Justice for violence prevention programs. Under the bill, DOJ must consult with the Department of Health Services to determine grant awards.

Grant applications are due no later than June 30 of each fiscal year. The department of justice shall consult with the department of health services to determine grant awards under this section.
