1	Relating to: confirming Wisconsin's commitment to American democracy and the
2	orderly and peaceful transfer of power called for in the Constitution of the
3	United States.
4	Whereas, the United States is founded on the principle that our government
5	derives its power from the consent of the governed and that the people have the right
6	to change their elected leaders through elections; and
7	Whereas, our domestic tranquility, national security, general welfare, and civil
8	liberties depend upon the peaceful and orderly transfer of power; and
9	Whereas, any disruption occasioned by the transfer of the executive power
10	could produce results detrimental to the safety and well-being of the United States
11	and its people; now, therefore, be it
12	Resolved by the assembly, That the members of the Wisconsin State
13	Assembly reaffirm their commitment to the orderly and peaceful transfer of power
14	called for in the Constitution of the United States, and condemn any disruptions by
