## 2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 1109

February 23, 2024 - Introduced by Representatives JACOBSON, ORTIZ-VELEZ, STUBBS, BARE, OHNSTAD, BALDEH, SNODGRASS, CLANCY, RATCLIFF, PALMERI, CONLEY, SUBECK, JOERS, MADISON, MYERS, SHELTON and SINICKI, cosponsored by Senators AGARD, ROYS and SPREITZER. Referred to Committee on Health, Aging and Long-Term Care.

1     **AN ACT to create** 20.435 (5) (em) and 46.234 (9) of the statutes; **relating to:**  
2     supporting recovery residences and making an appropriation.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to encourage the development, expansion, and quality control of networks of recovery residences and to allocate moneys to create a grant program for establishing recovery residences or a network of recovery residences or to award grants for purposes specified in the bill. Current law defines a “recovery residence” as a home-like, residential environment that promotes healthy recovery from a substance use disorder and supports a person’s recovery from a substance use disorder through the use of peer recovery support.
