2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 921

January 10, 2024 - Introduced by Representatives BORN, WITKE, VOS, BEHNKE, BINSFELD, DUCHOW, KATSMA, KRUG, KURTZ, MAGNAFICI, MAXEY, MELOTIK, MURSAU, NOVAK, O'CONNOR, PENTERMAN, PLUMER, SCHMIDT, SWEARINGEN and MURPHY, cosponsored by Senators MARKLEIN, COWLES, LEMAHIEU, BALLWEG, FEYEN, JAMES, TESTIN, WIMBERGER and FELZKOWSKI. Referred to Joint Committee on Finance.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 20.866 (2) (t) and 20.867 (3) (x) of the statutes; and *to affect*
2 2023 Wisconsin Act 19, section 9104 (1) (i) 1. em. and es., 2023 Wisconsin Act
3 19, section 9104 (1) (i) 3. ed., eh., ep. and et., 2023 Wisconsin Act 19, section 9104
4 (1) (i) 4. fm. and fs. and 2023 Wisconsin Act 19, section 9104 (1) (i) 4g.; **relating**
5 **to:** amendments to the 2023-25 capital budget for University of Wisconsin
6 System projects, granting bonding authority, and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill amends the 2023-25 Authorized State Building Program to add the following projects for the University of Wisconsin System:

1. UW-Madison: demolition of an engineering facility and construction of a replacement engineering building.
2. UW-Madison: Kronshage-Jorns-Humphrey Residence Halls additions and renovations.
3. UW-Whitewater: Winther/Heide Hall entry additions and renovations.
4. Systemwide: demolition projects.
5. Systemwide: central plants and utility distribution renovations.

In addition to moneys contributed from other funding sources, such as gifts and program revenues, the bill transfers \$423,273,000 from the general fund to the capital improvement fund for the purpose of funding these projects, except that the UW-Madison Kronshage-Jorns-Humphrey Residence Halls project is funded solely from program revenue supported borrowing and program revenues.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 1.** 20.866 (2) (t) of the statutes, as affected by 2023 Wisconsin Act 19,
2 is amended to read:

3 20.866 (2) (t) *University of Wisconsin; self-amortizing facilities.* From the
4 capital improvement fund, a sum sufficient for the board of regents of the University
5 of Wisconsin System to acquire, construct, develop, enlarge, or improve university
6 self-amortizing educational facilities and facilities to support such facilities. The
7 state may contract public debt in an amount not to exceed \$2,740,855,400 for this
8 purpose. The state may contract additional public debt in an amount up to
9 \$435,866,700 for this purpose. The state may contract additional public debt in an
10 amount up to \$83,875,000 for this purpose. The state may contract additional public
11 debt in an amount up to \$164,922,000 for this purpose. The state may contract
12 additional public debt in an amount up to \$110,219,000 for this purpose. Of those
13 amounts, \$4,500,000 is allocated only for the University of Wisconsin-Madison
14 indoor practice facility for athletic programs and only at the time that ownership of
15 the facility is transferred to the state.

16 **SECTION 2.** 20.867 (3) (x) of the statutes, as created by 2023 Wisconsin Act 19,
17 is amended to read:

18 20.867 (3) (x) *Segregated revenue supported building program projects;*
19 *inflationary project cost overruns.* From the capital improvement fund, as a
20 continuing appropriation, all moneys transferred under 2023 Wisconsin Act 19,
21 section 9251 (1), and 2023 Wisconsin Act ... (this act), section 9251 (1), to fund the

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1 projects enumerated under 2023 Wisconsin Act 19, section 9104 (1), including the
2 project created by 2023 Wisconsin Act ... (this act), section 4, in the amounts
3 designated as “segregated revenue” in that section for those projects; to fund the
4 other expenditures and allocations designated as “segregated revenue” under 2023
5 Wisconsin Act 19, section 9104 (4) to (13); and to offset building program project
6 budget cost overruns caused by inflation under s. 13.48 (2) (L) in a total amount up
7 to \$20,000,000.
