## **CHAPTER 85**

## **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

85.01 Planning 85.02 Federal reduction or termination of aid. 85.03 Special assistant for safety and law enforcement.

85.01 Planning. The department of transportation may direct and undertake all planning in the areas of highways, motor vehicles, traffic law enforcement, aeronautics, mass transit systems and for any other transportation mode. All state, regional and municipal agencies created pursuant to statute law shall to the extent practicable, when dealing with transportation, recognize and give due regard to recommendations made by the secretary of transportation. The department may direct and undertake planning for ports, harbors and waterways when requested by a state, regional or municipal agency or harbor commission.

85.02 Federal reduction or termination of aid. All appropriations made to the department

of transportation under s. 20.395 are subject to the specific provision that if federal government funding of any portion of a program under s. 20.395 is reduced or terminated, the secretary of transportation may terminate or reduce state participation in the program in such proportion as he deems appropriate

85.03 Special assistant for safety and law enforcement. The secretary of transportation shall nominate, and with the advice and consent of the senate appoint, a special assistant for safety and law enforcement, for a 4-year term expiring on March 1, 1975, and quadrennially thereafter.
