SUBJECT: Preliminary 2021-22 Transportation Fund Revenue Collections

Information regarding transportation fund revenue collections for 2021-22 is now available. According to the Department of Transportation (DOT), annual net transportation fund revenue collections, after transportation revenue bond debt service is paid, totaled \$2,146.4 million in 2021-22. The final estimate of net transportation fund collections estimated under 2021 Act 58 (the 2021-23 budget) was \$2,109.3 million. Thus, the preliminary 2021-22 actual transportation fund collections were \$37.1 million, or 1.8%, above the Act 58 estimate.

In addition, the 2021-22 opening balance in the transportation fund was \$13.1 million higher than under the Act 58 estimate. Along with the \$37.1 million in additional 2021-22 annual revenue, \$50.2 million more in total revenues were available to the transportation fund in 2021-22 than was estimated under Act 58.

By October 15, 2022, DOT's final 2021-22 expenditures will be available. Changes to expenditures compared to the Act 58 amounts would also impact the 2022-23 opening balance in the transportation fund.

The attached table shows a comparison of the estimated and actual preliminary 2021-22 transportation fund revenue collections, along with the differences between the estimated and actual amounts. The figures in the table are based on a report of 2021-22 revenues provided by DOT.
