**SENATE AMENDMENT 17,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 21**

July 7, 2015 – Offered by Senators MILLER, ERPENBACH, LASSA, HANSEN, WIRCH, L. TAYLOR, RINGHAND, BEWLEY, HARRIS DODD, VINEHOUT, RISSER and SHILLING.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 30, line 10: delete that line.

3 **2.** Page 101, line 7: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
4 \$671,300 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$671,300 for the
5 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

6 **3.** Page 124, line 20: delete lines 20 to 22 and substitute:

7 “(r) Environmental education; envi-

8 ronmental assessments SEG C 130,500 130,500

9 (rc) Environmental education; fore-

10 stry SEG A 200,000 200,000”.

11 **4.** Page 125, line 1: delete lines 1 to 4 and substitute:

1	“(s) Wisconsin Bioenergy Initiative	SEG	A	4,069,100	4,069,100
2	(tb) Extension recycling education	SEG	A	394,100	394,100
3	(tm) Solid waste research and exper-

5 **5.** Page 131, line 14: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
6 \$4,668,800 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$4,668,800 for
7 the purpose of increasing the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural
8 resources by 44.68 GPR state parks and state recreation areas positions.

9 **6.** Page 132, line 12: after that line insert:

10	“(gu) State park operations	SEG	A	1,445,000	1,445,000”.
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11 **7.** Page 134, line 11: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
12 \$80,700 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$80,700, and
13 adjust the NET APPROPRIATION totals accordingly, for the purpose of increasing
14 the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural resources by 1.0 SEG
15 educator position.

16 **8.** Page 134, line 12: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
17 \$242,700 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$242,700, and
18 adjust the NET APPROPRIATION totals accordingly, for the purpose of increasing
19 the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural resources by 3.0 SEG
20 educator positions.

21 **9.** Page 134, line 12: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
22 \$3,224,500 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$3,224,500,
23 and adjust the NET APPROPRIATION totals accordingly, for the purpose of

1 decreasing the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural resources by
2 44.68 SEG state parks and state recreation areas positions.

3 **10.** Page 137, line 17: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
4 \$79,400 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$79,400 for the
5 purpose of increasing the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural
6 resources by 1.0 SEG educator position.

7 **11.** Page 139, line 15: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
8 \$103,800 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$103,800 for the
9 purpose of increasing the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural
10 resources by 1.25 PR science services positions.

11 **12.** Page 140, line 9: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
12 \$50,400 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$50,400 for the
13 purpose of increasing the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural
14 resources by 0.5 SEG science services position.

15 **13.** Page 140, line 11: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
16 \$793,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$793,000 for the
17 purpose of increasing the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural
18 resources by 7.4 SEG science services positions.

19 **14.** Page 144, line 11: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
20 \$21,200 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$21,200 for the
21 purpose of increasing the authorized FTE positions for the department of natural
22 resources by 0.25 SEG educator position.

1 **15.** Page 145, line 13: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
2 \$7,400 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$7,400 for the
3 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

4 **16.** Page 145, line 18: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
5 \$22,200 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$22,200 for the
6 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

7 **17.** Page 145, line 19: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2015–16 by
8 \$73,500 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$73,500 for the
9 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

11 \$7,400 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$7,400 for the
12 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

14 \$250,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016–17 by \$500,000 for the
15 purpose of providing grants for collaborative development of sustainable urban
16 forestry programs under s. 23.097 (1s).

19 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

11 “**SECTION 620m.** 20.370 (1) (gu) of the statutes is created to read:

12 20.370 (1) (gu) *State park operations.* The amounts in the schedule for state
13 parks operations.”.

14 **27.** Page 350, line 18: delete lines 18 and 19 and substitute “The state may
15 contract public debt in an amount not to exceed \$1,134,500,000 for this program.
16 Except as provided in s. 23.0917 (4g) (b), (4m) (k),”.

17 **28.** Page 351, line 2: delete lines 2 to 4 and substitute “2014–15, may not
18 exceed \$54,500,000 in fiscal year 2015–16, and may not exceed \$50,000,000 in each
19 fiscal year beginning with fiscal year 2016–17 and ending with fiscal year 2019–20.”.

23 **31.** Page 374, line 18: after that line insert:

1 **“SECTION 963m.** 23.097 (1s) of the statutes is created to read:

2 23.097 (1s) In addition to the grants awarded under subs. (1g) and (1r), the
3 department shall award urban forestry grants to groups of 3 or more eligible
4 recipients for the purpose of the collaborative development of sustainable urban
5 forestry programs. The department shall award grants under this subsection in the
6 amount of \$250,000 in fiscal year 2015–16 and in the amount of \$500,000 in fiscal
7 year 2016–17 and in each fiscal year thereafter. The department may award a grant
8 to a group only if the group is comprised of at least one city, one county, and a least
9 one or more of the following entities:

10 (a) A federally recognized Indian tribe or band.

11 (b) A local unit of government.

12 (c) A nonprofit organization specializing in sustainable urban agriculture or
13 forest programs.

14 (d) A private business specializing in sustainable forestry management.

15 **SECTION 963p.** 23.099 of the statutes is created to read:

16 **23.099 Reports.** Each recipient of a grant or other funding awarded under s.
17 23.0955, 23.0956, 23.0957, 23.295, 26.39 (7), 281.69, or 281.72 shall provide an
18 annual report to the department for any year during which a grant or funding was
19 awarded to the recipient. The report shall include information on the recipient’s
20 overall budget and activities and shall provide details regarding the recipient’s use
21 of the funds, including how funded activities furthered the conservation goals of this
22 state.

23 **SECTION 963q.** 23.11 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

24 23.11 (1m) The department’s mission is to do all of the following:

25 (a) Protect and enhance this state’s natural resources.

1 (b) Protect this state’s wildlife, fish, and forests and the ecosystems that sustain
2 all life.

3 (c) Provide a healthy and sustainable environment and a full range of outdoor
4 opportunities.

5 (d) Ensure the right of all people to use and enjoy, in their work and leisure, this
6 state’s natural resources.

7 (e) Work with people to help people to understand one another’s views and to
8 carry out the public will.

9 (f) Promote partnerships that consider the future and generations to follow.”.

14 section 20.370 (4) (mz) of the statutes, as affected by this act.

15 (b) The authorized FTE positions for the department of natural resources are
16 increased by 1.0 FED educator position to be funded from the appropriation under
17 section 20.370 (9) (mz) of the statutes, as affected by this act.

18 (c) The authorized FTE positions for the department of natural resources are
19 increased by 1.0 SEG educator position to be funded from the appropriation under
20 section 20.370 (9) (iq) of the statutes, as affected by this act.

21 (d) The authorized FTE positions for the department of natural resources are
22 increased by 9.25 FED science services positions to be funded from the appropriation
23 under section 20.370 (3) (my) of the statutes, as affected by this act.”.

48. Page 1531, line 22: after that line insert:

“(9u) WISCONSIN BIOENERGY INITIATIVE. The authorized FTE positions for the University of Wisconsin System Board of Regents are increased by 35.2 SEG positions, to be funded from the appropriation under section 20.285 (1) (s) of the statutes, for the purpose of supporting research and development under the Wisconsin Bioenergy Initiative.

(9v) EXTENSION RECYCLING EDUCATION. The authorized FTE positions for the University of Wisconsin System Board of Regents are increased by 4.0 SEG positions, to be funded from the appropriation under section 20.285 (1) (tb) of the statutes, for the purpose of supporting University of Wisconsin–Extension recycling education.

(9w) SOLID WASTE RESEARCH AND EXPERIMENTS. The authorized FTE positions for the University of Wisconsin System Board of Regents are increased by 1.0 SEG position, to be funded from the appropriation under section 20.285 (1) (tm) of the statutes, for the purpose of supporting solid waste research and experiments.”.
