## 1999 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

The 1999 Adopted Budget for Milwaukee County includes expenditures of \$1,008,795,711, revenues of \$814,589,368, and tax levy of \$194,206,343, which is a 2.78% increase over the 1998 adopted tax levy for Milwaukee County of \$188,945,714. Two of the most significant issues contained in the 1999 Budget are the continued and significantly increased funding for the County's Year 2000 effort and the significant funding increases for operation of the Sheriff's Department and the House of Correction. Funding is also provided in the 1999 Budget for continuation of the County's strategic planning effort. These and other initiatives/changes are discussed below.

### ONGOING INITIATIVES

#### Year 2000 Preparation

The primary objective of the Information Management Services Division's (IMSD) 1999 budget is to apply all available resources to the Year 2000 readiness effort for Milwaukee County. Other than essential ongoing operating and support activities, all information technology staff will be concentrating on establishing Milwaukee County's preparedness for January 1, 2000. The 1999 MSD operating budget includes approximately \$2.5 million for staff, contractual and equipment costs related to this effort. Included in this expenditure is approximately \$1 million for 22 technical positions for Year 2000 readiness work. These positions are designated to terminate on or before March 31, 2002. The ABACUS/Year 2000 Transition capital budget includes \$15.8 million for system infrastructure, hardware and other improvements related to this effort.

#### Strategic Planning

To continue efforts to develop a long-range ongoing strategic planning framework for County operations, an appropriation of \$25,000 is included in the 1999 budget. The funds are intended to be used for ongoing planning activities and initiatives identified by the Long Range Planning Steering Committee, created in May 1998. A "Strategic Simulation" exercise, conducted in November 1997, was designed to identify the strategic priorities of Milwaukee County in the year 2002 to meet constituent needs and maintain fiscal accountability. A consultant will work with the Steering Committee and County staff to develop the next phase of the strategic plan.

### NEW INITIATIVES

#### Services to the Elderly

The Department on Aging has consolidated more than 15 separate aging programs and provides a single point of access to County services for older people and their families. The Department on Aging has been selected to begin a single entry Point/Management Care Pilot Project under the State's new Long Term Care Redesign initiative.

#### Department of Public Works/Department of Human Services Maintenance Transfer

In 1999, the Department of Public Works will assume facility and maintenance functions for DHS at the Children's Court Center and the 12<sup>th</sup> and Villet building. The cost of all positions related to this initiative are budgeted in DPW which will crosscharge DHS for all costs related to the provision of these services at the Children's Court Center and 12<sup>th</sup> and Villet.

#### Bi-County Child Care Initiative

A Bi-County Child Care Initiative by Milwaukee County, Waukesha County and the State of Wisconsin is established for the development of an Employer Sponsored Child Care Options Group. This initiative will be designed to meet the needs of employers for information and technical assistance in implementing child care solutions for their employees. The group will serve as a clearinghouse for child care information on a wide range of options. An appropriation of \$25,000 is established as Milwaukee County's commitment, funded with State Day Care Administration revenues.

#### Weekend Sanction Program

Funding of \$60,448 is included to initiate a Weekend Sanction Program for participants in juvenile day treatment programs. This program will provide four components: 1) Youth in violation of juvenile court orders will be required to spend their weekends in the Detention Center, 2) Day Treatment agencies will provide educational programming of six hours on

Saturday and Sunday, 3) Clothing and regular pod staffing will be funded from the budget for the Detention Center, and 4) a new position of Volunteer Coordinator is to be created, offset by the abolishment of a position of Juvenile Recreation Officer.

Health Program for Children

The 1999 Budget includes a new initiative, Team Up for Health, which seeks partnerships for the establishment of a year-round organized sports activities program for seven to 12-year-old children who reside in Milwaukee County. The Program's goal is to have a positive impact on the health, health habits, and mental outlook of the participating children. In addition to teaching the fundamentals of a particular sport, a healthier life style concept will be introduced which includes, but is not limited to, the benefits of balanced nutrition, the impact of smoking, drugs and alcohol and interpersonal skills development. Funding of \$25,000 is budgeted for this program with matching grants from outside sources anticipated.

**DEPARTMENTAL CHANGES**

Milwaukee County Research Park

Future land sales at the Research Park are expected to be enhanced with the completion of \$2.5 million in infrastructure improvements to the grounds. The improvements will be funded with a \$1.8 million expansion of the City of Wauwatosa's Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) and through a \$700,000 loan from Milwaukee County to the Research Park Board. The loan shall be repaid in seven equal annual installments with interest. Overall, the Research Park is anticipating land sale revenue to provide Milwaukee County with a negative tax levy of \$250,000 in addition to the repayment of the infrastructure improvement loan.

Department of Administration - Risk Management

The contribution to the claim reserve is reduced \$400,000, from \$550,000 in 1998 to \$150,000, based on a review of current claim reserves.

Department of Administration - Housing and Community Development

HUD waived the matching requirement for the HOME Investment Partnership Program for 1998 as disaster relief. Therefore \$110,000 in tax levy funds appropriated in 1998 will be used to meet the match obligation of 1999 HOME funds. Two Housing Program Assistant-Rent Assistance positions are established to service 75 additional rental assistance vouchers under the Low Income Housing Preservation Program. The conversion of project-based Shelter Plus Care rental assistance units to tenant-based rental assistance units results in up to 150 additional units to administer. Administrative fees, earned as units are leased, will be new revenue and will cover the cost of these staff positions (\$57,584) and related equipment (\$8,684), resulting in no increased tax levy. A \$10,000 tax levy increase results from a professional service contract to provide consulting services to define, develop and implement an ongoing community Continuum of Care so community agencies can continue to receive federal funds for housing and supportive services to homeless populations. It is anticipated that involved community agencies will provide \$10,000 of matching funds.

Combined Court Related Operations

The Bench Warrant Removal Project is institutionalized for 1999 to provide regular reviews of old bench warrants that cannot or will not be prosecuted. The Booking Magistrate Program is discontinued in 1999, partly due to the success of Sunday Intake Court Operations that were implemented in 1998. One additional Assistant Family Court Commissioner position was created in late 1998 to meet increased workloads. The Local Law Enforcement Block Grant will provide \$131,702 to purchase additional video conferencing technology and cover 90% of the personal service costs of a new position of Video Conferencing Technician to oversee the initiative. One position of Post Conviction Motion Attorney was also approved to meet increased workloads. Bailiff charges from the Sheriff are expected to total \$5,625,001 for 1999 due to the conversion in 1998 of two existing probate court calendars to criminal and to provide adequate coverage of Sunday Intake Court operations.

Child Support Enforcement

The Department of Child Support Enforcement will be participating in a State Performance Standard Initiative to increase the performance of collections, paternity establishment, order establishment and cost effectiveness for 1999. An additional 30 positions are created for 1999, offset with the abolishment of two existing positions, to help improve the department's performance. Overall, the department is expecting to provide a negative tax levy of \$3,950,968, an increase of \$140,581 over the 1998 Adopted amount.

Department of Public Works - Transit Services Division  
 The Transit System has no fare increases for 1999 and includes various service increases which are partially offset by passenger fare revenue and Federal Congestion Mitigation Air Quality funding. Service increases include added service on weekends and late night on existing routes, expansion of Route 68 to serve employment areas around Green Bay Road and Bender Road including the Glendale Industrial Park, and a new Express bus serving the House of Correction in Franklin. The continuation of routes added during the I-94 repaving project is also included.

Department of Public Works - Highway Maintenance Division  
 The Highway Maintenance Division will work with the State Department of Transportation regarding the mowing policy on State Trunk Highway Medians. The Division will also develop a plan by the March County Board committee cycle for increasing the frequency of mowing, turf maintenance and beautification of the County Trunk and State Trunk Highway system under its jurisdiction.

Department of Public Works - Transportation Services Division and Professional Services Division  
 In 1999, the Department of Public Works-Professional Services Division will separate into two divisions - Transportation Services and Professional Services Division. The Professional Services Division is comprised of two sections - Architecture and Engineering Services and Environment and Energy Services. The administration of the Digger's Hotline is transferred from the Transportation Services Division into the Highway Maintenance Division.

House of Correction  
 Tax levy support for the House of Correction increases \$4,612,719 over the 1998 adopted amount as preparations continue for an additional 1,000 beds to be available in 1999. A total of 177 new positions are created, offset with the abolishment of eight existing positions, to provide sworn and civilian staff support functions for the expanded Adult Correctional Center facility. An agreement with the State of Wisconsin to house up to 300 Violators of Probation or Parole (VOPs) is expected to commence in May. The House of Correction expects to receive \$1,997,656 to offset operational costs associated with housing the State prisoners. An additional \$2,765,694 paid by the State under this agreement is earmarked for debt service costs of the 400-bed expansion. The 400-bed expansion was approved after the 600-bed expansion was authorized and mostly constructed. The House of Correction will administer a Day Reporting Center program with an outside vendor to provide substance abuse treatment, education, developmental programs, and employment assistance to an average daily population of 30 individuals in 1999. The County commitment for the 13 month project begun in October, 1998, is budgeted at \$386,065.

Sheriff  
 For 1999, tax levy support for the Sheriff increases \$1,280,606 over the 1998 adopted amount. A total of 42 new sworn and civilian positions are created, offset with the abolishment of six existing positions. Many of the new staff are to provide fiscal and health services support for the expanded inmate population at the House of Correction. The Detention Bureau will continue to house up to 125 State Violators of Probation (VOPs) for \$4,900 per day plus outside medical and prescription drug expenses. A Deputy Sheriff liaison/expediter post will also be implemented within the District Attorney's charging unit to allow for the timely release of individuals that will not be incarcerated. A new inmate telephone contract is expected to generate \$2,750,000 in commissions from inmates housed at the Jail and House of Correction facilities. The Sheriff will assume the administration of the Metropolitan Milwaukee Drug Enforcement Group (MMDEG) grant from the District Attorney in 1999. This transfer results in a \$1,177,551 tax levy reduction for the Sheriff, completely offset with a \$1,177,551 tax levy increase for the District Attorney.

Register of Deeds  
 Revenues increase \$371,190 due to increases in General Recording Fees revenue (\$159,426) and Real Estate Transfer Fees revenue (\$211,764), resulting from the ongoing strength in the real estate sales and mortgage industries. An appropriation of \$38,000 is included to automate the corporate records index, including scanning 116,000 filing cards into an optical imaging system, permanently securing these records. The budget includes \$56,791 for the increased cost of repair and maintenance contracts for the optical imaging system implemented in 1998.

Election Commission  
 Since 1999 is a two election year, workload reductions result in a \$283,420 decrease in expenditures including overtime of computer software, hardware and training will enable the Election Commission to program the Programmable Read-Only Memory Pacs (PROMPacs) used in electronic voting machines, instead of shipping these critical components out of state (\$2,420), advertising (\$25,000), and ballots and election supplies (\$256,000). An appropriation of \$56,140 for the purchase of computer software, hardware and training will enable the Election Commission to program the Programmable Read-Only Memory Pacs (PROMPacs) used in electronic voting machines, instead of shipping these critical components out of state for programming.

Department of Public Works - Paratransit Services Division

The Paratransit Services Division will continue to implement the redesigned Paratransit Services system that was begun in August of 1998. Where in the past, the Transit Plus Program operated with 16 van service vendors, as of August 1998, there are two agencies serving the Transit Plus program. Laidlaw and Transit Express. Significant changes in the services include the responsibility for clients being divided geographically by north versus south and vendors being paid by the hour rather than by the ride, as in the past. The Paratransit Services Division is expected to have met ADA compliance as of December 31, 1998.

Department of Human Services - Mental Health Division

The 1999 tax levy for the MHD increases \$1,795,184, from \$20,842,741 to \$22,637,925.

Adult Inpatient Services Branch. Rehabilitation Centers/Nursing Facility Services revenue increases \$552,390 due to a higher Medicaid per diem rate, as well as a patient census increase from 107 to 109 at the Hilltop facility. Acute Adult Services will close one 24-bed unit as a result of a decrease in Title XIX admissions. This closure reduces inpatient services expenditures by \$1,353,606 and revenues by \$869,996. The net cost savings resulting from the inpatient unit closure will be used to support 10.5 positions in the Adult Community Services Branch, Adult Crisis Services Branch, Management/Support Services and the Adult Inpatient Services Branch - Rehabilitation Centers where programs or services will be expanded or enhanced.

Adult Community Services Branch. In accordance with the Five Year Master Plan for Public Sector Mental Health Systems for Adults in Milwaukee County, the Community Support Program (CSP) is expanded by 54 slots, serving an additional 40 individuals in the Targeted Case Management (TCM) program and enhancing services for consumers presently in these programs. In order to expand CSP and TCM services, the following new positions are created: three Economic Support Specialist, two Community Nurse Specialist and one Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor, which will be funded by an increase in Title XIX Case Management and CSP revenue of \$201,084. As a result of a change in the financial classification of individuals served in the MHD Adult Outpatient Clinic and the Day Treatment program, patient service revenues have been reduced by \$150,000.

Child and Adolescent Services Branch. The Wraparound Program revenues increase to \$34,064,016 which includes State Medicaid capitation and Fee for Service revenues. The Wraparound Program will use \$27,777,076 of these funds to provide and purchase services for 680 severely emotionally disturbed children referred from the Children's Court System. The remaining \$6,286,940 will be used to operate the Safety Services Program at two sites for the State Division of Children and Family Services. Funding from these programs will be used to support the creation of one Quality Assurance/Quality Improvement Coordinator position and the transfer of five positions from the Department of Human Services which will provide management, supervisory and clerical support for the Safety Services and expanded Wraparound Programs. The Child and Adolescent Services Branch also includes a new \$225,000 grant from the Office of Justice Assistance to fund a Chronic Serious Juvenile Offender Program through December, 1999.

Intergovernmental Transfer Program

The Intergovernmental Transfer Program revenue is forecast to increase \$500,000, from \$1,700,000 in 1998 to \$2,200,000 in 1999, based on previous years' experience.

Department of Administration - County Health Related Programs

The Emergency Medical Services program has restructured its fees for 1999 to address the provision of services to entities outside of Milwaukee County and the establishment of the Training Center as a Community Health Training Center (IHTC) and its Heart Association. The 1999 Budget reflects the privatization of the International Health Training Center (IHTC) and its discontinuation as a County operated program. A \$50,000 grant to the IHTC program is continued in the 1999 Budget. GAMP expenditures for 1999 related to the provision of medical services remain unchanged from the prior year and State reimbursement for medical expenditures remains budgeted at 45%.

Department on Aging

Tax levy funding for transportation services increases \$149,824 to address reductions in transportation options resulting from changes to the County's Paratransit Services Program.

Department of Human Services

Base Community Aids. The 1999 Budget assumes no reduction in Base Community Aids (BCA). Since budget adopted however, the State Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) has advised counties of a 2.9% reduction in their 1999

BCA allocations, to reflect a 17% cut in the Federal Social Services Block Grant (SSBG) allocation to Wisconsin. DHS originally estimated this 2.9% cut in BCA at approximately \$675,000. Staff calculated this reduction on \$23.4 million of net BCA. The formal written notice to the County of its 1999 BCA allocation reveals the State calculated the reduction on the basis of gross BCA of approximately \$82 million. In applying the calculated funding reduction, the State excluded the \$58.9 million in BCA that is intercepted by the State to fund the State's Child Welfare system. Consequently, the entire BCA funding shortfall, estimated at \$3.2 million, would be applied to the County's net BCA of \$23.4 million resulting in an actual 13.9% reduction in net BCA. The County is attempting to work with the State to identify alternatives to these drastic cuts. If solutions are not forthcoming, it is anticipated that reductions in services will be identified by the Department of Human Services and recommended for action by the County Board and County Executive.

Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse (AODA). AODA revenues of \$1.4 million are reallocated and AODA services are reduced \$2.5 million to avoid a \$4.2 million deficit in 1999 and to bring expenditures in line with budget appropriations. DHS shall keep overall tax levy expenditures for AODA services to the amounts in the budget, but is granted flexibility to work with outside groups and other interested parties to achieve additional revenues. Should DHS locate additional revenues, it shall have the discretion to apply those additional revenues where the Department determines would provide the greatest benefits. Any additional revenues received and program restorations implemented shall be reported to the Health and Human Needs Committee and the Finance and Audit Committee.

Youth Aids. There is a \$324,000 gap in State Youth Aids funding for juveniles incarcerated in State institutions and residential facilities, resulting from a 19% rate increase for residential programs without a corresponding Youth Aids revenue increase. Combined with the \$3.7 million in tax levy added to the 1998 budget to address a Youth Aids shortfall, this represents a \$4 million State funding problem over two years.

W-2. Expenditures for W-2 Day Care payments are reduced from \$67 million in 1998 to \$17 million in 1999 to reflect State takeover of payments beginning April 1, 1999, when the State's new computer system is anticipated to be operative. A policy statement is included in the Budget to work with the State in making the W-2 program more responsive to participants. Specifically, W-2 should include more men in its employment programs, provide a greater focus on education and job training. relax co-payment requirements for child care services for participants, and provide the same reimbursement per client to all agencies.

Information and Referral. A \$25,000 tax levy appropriation is established as the County's share of costs for an information and referral hotline.

Parks Department increases \$1,250,059, from \$1,752,203 to \$1,877,209. Based on previous years' experience, the Park Armenty Matching Fund is reduced \$100,000, from \$200,000 to \$100,000, resulting in a tax levy reduction of \$50,000 to reflect the County's 50% match. Various Park fees are increased, including golf permits and marina slip rental fees, to provide additional revenue for increased operating expenses. One seasonal parking pass fee is established for both the Wehr Nature Center and Boerner Botanical Gardens and a new annual registration fee is created for all auxiliary vessels kept at the McKinley Marina.

Zoological Department 1999 tax levy for the Zoological Department increases \$814,212, from \$937,857 to \$1,752,069, primarily due to the following: a reduction in attendance revenue based on the actual mix of the various paid categories, an increase in salary and utility expenditures, and the shift in Zoological Society support from direct operational support to in-kind expenditure support. Zoological Society support for the Zoo totals \$1,556,480 in 1999 which includes \$689,850 in direct revenue, \$591,630 in direct in-kind support and \$275,000 in capital support. A "Jurassic Park - The Lost World" and "To See the Sea" exhibits are planned for 1999 to help the Zoo achieve its attendance level of 1,350,000 visitors.

Marcus Center for the Performing Arts The 1999 Budget authorizes the renewal of the memorandum of understanding between the County and the Marcus Center for the Performing Arts which provides an increase of \$100,000 for a total funding level of \$1,600,000 for the years 1999 through 2003.

**Employee Fringe Benefits**

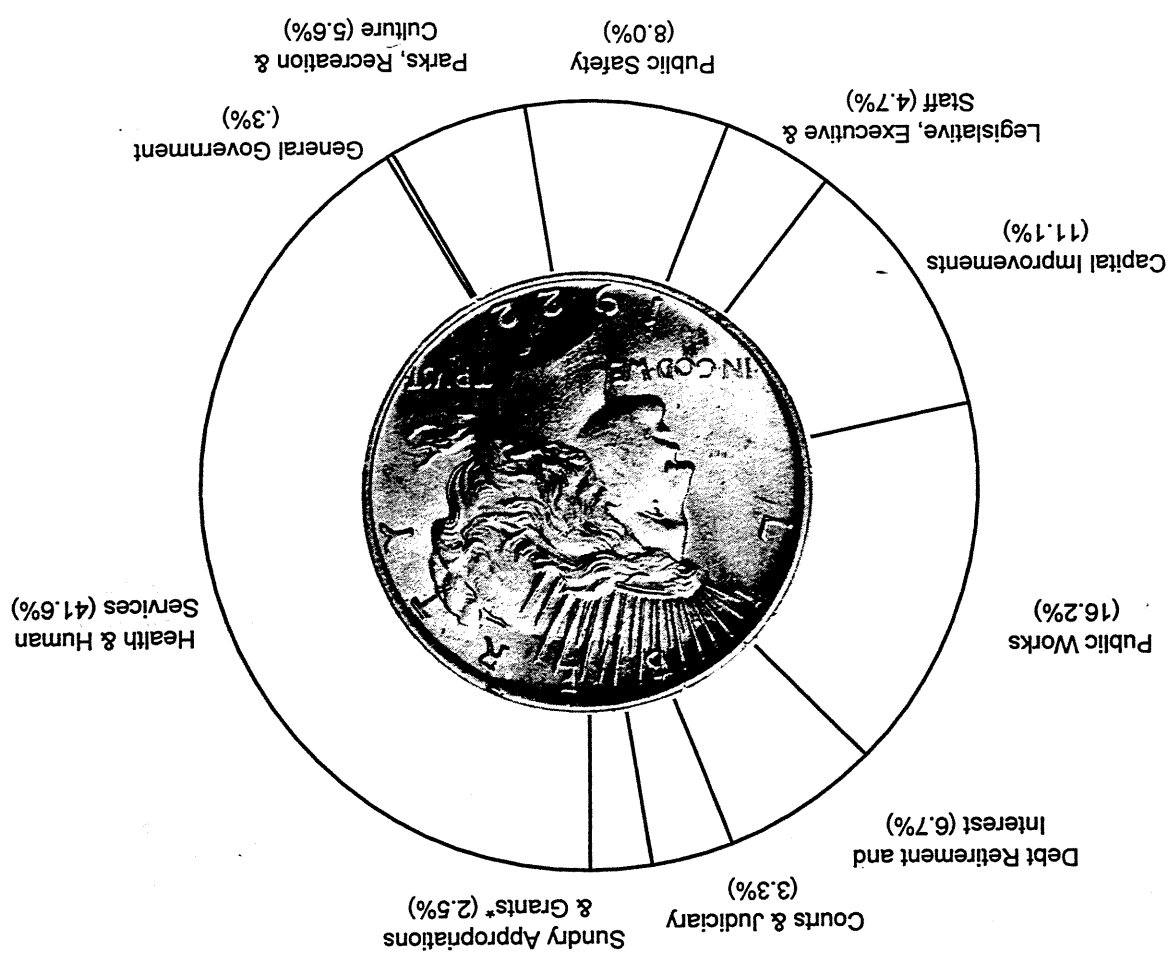
Total fringe benefits costs are reduced \$4 million in 1999, including an \$8 million reduction in Retirement System Contributions related to increases in investment returns and a reduction due to contribution variances and expenses, partially offset by a \$1 million increase in Health Benefit costs due to 8% and 12% increases for surgical/medical benefits and major medical, respectively.

**CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS**

The 1999 Adopted Capital Improvements Budget includes 81 projects with a total expenditure appropriation of \$112,007,169. Anticipated reimbursement revenues (federal, state and local grants) total \$40,598,374 resulting in a net County commitment of \$71,408,795. The general County capital improvement budget (corporate purpose projects) includes 70 projects totaling \$91,750,919 with offsetting reimbursement revenues of \$35,993,174. The resulting net County commitment of \$55,757,745 is to be financed by \$49,875,623 in general obligation corporate purpose bonds, \$1,750,000 in power plant sale revenues, \$231,000 in passenger facility charges revenue, \$1,567,522 in property taxes, \$33,600 in construction fund investment earnings, \$500,000 in land sale revenues and \$1,800,000 in revenue from the debt service reserve.

Adopted expenditure appropriations for 1999 airport capital improvements total \$20,256,250. Airport capital reimbursement revenue appropriations of \$4,605,200 result in a net County commitment of \$15,651,050. Financing for the net County commitment for airport projects includes \$8,744,650 in passenger facility charges revenue, \$6,750,000 in private activity, general obligation or revenue airport bonds, and \$156,400 in construction fund investment earnings.

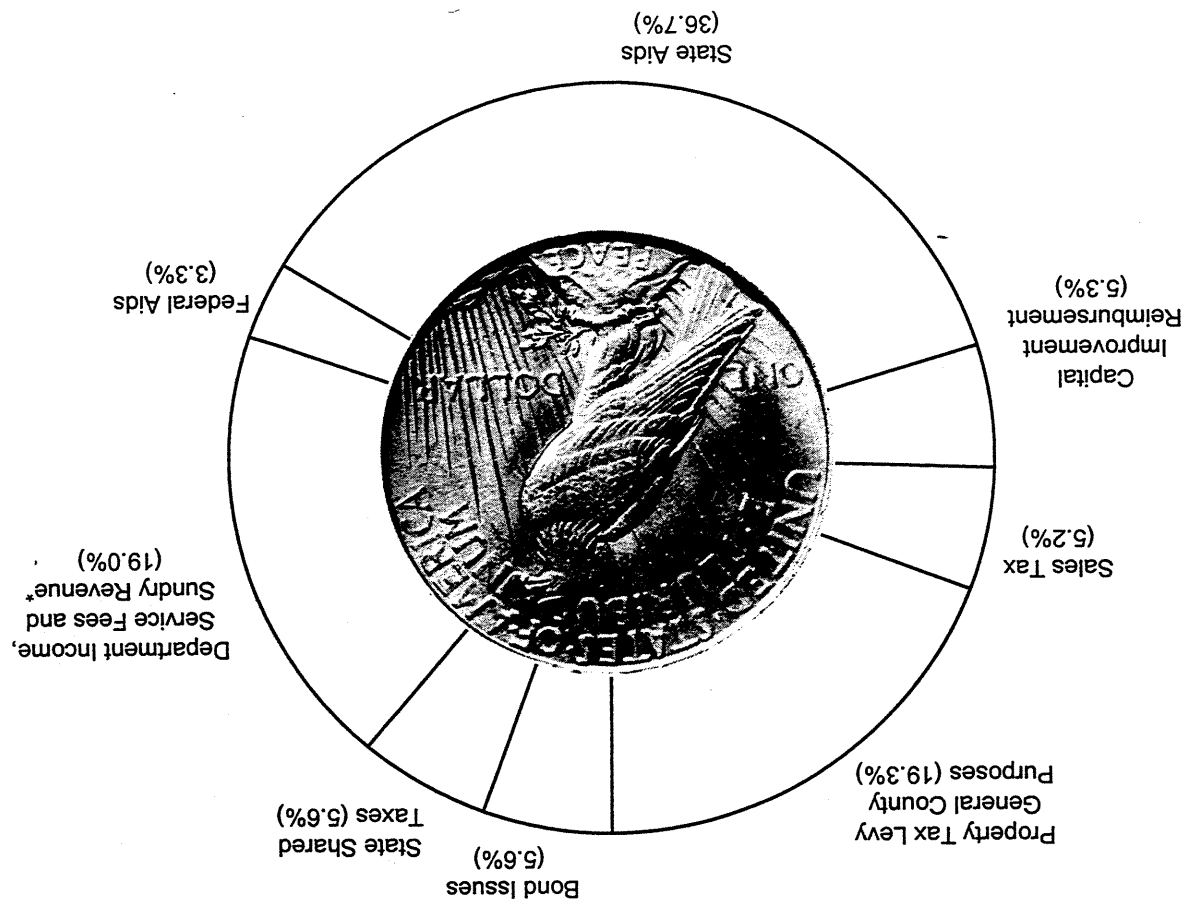
**MILWAUKEE COUNTY 1999 BUDGET DOLLAR
