the court they may perform all his duties; or in case of a vacancy by resignation, death, removal or other cause the deputy appointed shall perform all such duties until such vacancy shall be filled. The clerk shall be responsible on his official bond for all official default or misconduct of his deputies.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 207

AN ACT to amend section 11 of chapter 165 of the laws of 1903, as amended by section 4 of chapter 300 of the laws of 1905, and by section 1 of chapter 87 of the laws of 1907, relating to beneficiaries of the pension fund of the fire department in cities of the first class.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 11 of chapter 165 of the laws of 1903, as amended by section 4 of chapter 300 of the laws of 1905 and by section 1 of chapter 87 of the laws of 1907, is amended to read: (Ch. 87, laws of 1907) Section 11. This act shall apply to all present or hereafter contributing members of the fire—department, whether now members or hereafter becoming members except the physician and surgeon, veterinary surgeon, stenographer and emergency appointments. * * * All retiring firement or the widows, parents, children or executors of any—deceased fireman now drawing pensions under chapter 379 of the laws of Wisconsin for 1895 shall continue to receive monthly the same sums as they are now receiving and such sums shall hereafter be paid to them by the treasurers of such cities as provided by said chapter 379, laws of 1895, and they do not come within this act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
