ship association, Athens advancement and agricultural association, Janesville park association, Rusk county agricultural society, Elroy fair association, or any other agricultural society, association, or board. After July 1, 1917, state aid shall be paid to but one such society, association, or board for or in any county, except that societies, associations, and boards which received aid hereunder for fairs held during the calendar year 1916 may, upon substantial compliance with the conditions prescribed by law, continue to receive such aid until otherwise provided by law.

SECTION 2. All acts of the secretary of state and of the state treasurer heretofore had relating to the granting of state aid to fair associations or agricultural societies and the payments of state aid heretofore made to such associations and societies are hereby ratified, confirmed and validated.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 597

AN ACT relating to the work of circuit judges.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. One or more circuit judges may hold court and preside as judge of the municipal court for the city and county of Milwaukee, upon the request of the judge of said court, and such circuit judges shall attend and hold court for the purpose of trying any action in said municipal court. The judge of said municipal court may also hold court at the same time and exercise all powers of presiding judge and may try cases by jury.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
