## HAS 2.01 Trainees

**HAS 2.01 Trainees. (1)** An applicant for a trainee permit must make application on the form provided by the department. This form must be completed in full, and a check or cash in the amount of the fee specified under s. 440.05 (6), Stats., must accompany this application.

**(2)** A trainee permit issued by the board entitles the trainee to practice fitting hearing instruments, make ear impressions and make measurements of human hearing, for the purpose of fitting hearing instruments, for a period of one year and only while under the direct supervision of a hearing instrument specialist who holds a license issued under ch. 459, Stats. The licensee is responsible for the trainee's negligent acts and omissions in the fitting of hearing instruments. In order to exercise direct supervision, the sponsoring licensee must be physically present when the trainee makes ear impressions or measurements of human hearing, for the purpose of fitting or selling a hearing instrument, or fits or sells a hearing instrument.

**(3)** A trainee permit may be renewed or regranted only once and then only when the trainee shows sufficient cause for not having completed the requirements for a permanent license. Sufficient cause means illness or other incapacity or hardship.

**(4)** Only one trainee at a time may hold a trainee permit to practice fitting of hearing instruments under the supervision of a given licensee.

**(5)** A trainee permit will be revoked by the board upon receipt of written notice, signed by the trainee's supervising licensee, stating that the licensee wishes to cease supervising such trainee.
