



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 18,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 441**

September 21, 1995 - Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 6: delete “and providing a penalty” and substitute: “, the use  
3 of genetic tests by insurers, prohibiting requiring a woman to obtain an abortion  
4 based on the results of genetic testing of the fetus and providing penalties.”.

5 **2.** Page 19, line 15: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 10g.** 631.89 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 **631.89** (title) **Restrictions on the use of genetic test results tests.**

8 **Section 10h.** 631.89 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 631.89 (1) (intro.) and  
9 amended to read:

10 631.89 (1) (intro.) In this section, “genetic:

11 (a) “Genetic test” means a test using deoxyribonucleic acid extracted from an  
12 individual’s cells in order, including a physical examination of an individual or an  
13 examination of the family history of an individual, to determine the presence of a  
14 genetic disease or disorder or the individual’s predisposition for a particular any of  
15 the following:

1           1. Whether an individual has a genetic disease or disorder.

2           **Section 10i.** 631.89 (1) (a) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

3           631.89 (1) (a) 2. Whether an individual is predisposed to a genetic disease or  
4 disorder.

5           **Section 10j.** 631.89 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

6           631.89 (1) (b) “Individual” includes an unborn child.

7           **Section 10k.** 631.89 (1) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

8           631.89 (1) (c) “Unborn child” has the meaning given in s. 20.927 (4).

9           **Section 10L.** 631.89 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

10           631.89 (1) (d) “Underwriting process” means the process of risk evaluation and  
11 selection conducted by an insurer, or a person providing health care services for  
12 individuals on a self-insured basis, with respect to an individual who is covered  
13 under a policy or enrolled in a plan or who is seeking coverage under a policy or  
14 enrollment in a plan.

15           **Section 10m.** 631.89 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

16           631.89 (2) (intro.) An insurer that offers health care coverage, or a county, city,  
17 village or school board that provides health care services for individuals on a  
18 self-insured basis, may not, in its underwriting process, do any of the following:

19           **Section 10n.** 631.89 (2) (a) and (b) of the statutes are repealed.

20           **Section 10p.** 631.89 (2) (c) of the statutes is renumbered 631.89 (2) (am) and  
21 amended to read:

22           631.89 (2) (am) Condition the provision of insurance coverage or health care  
23 benefits on whether an individual or a member of the individual’s family, including  
24 an unborn child, has obtained a genetic test or what the results of the any such test,  
25 ~~if obtained by the individual or a member of the individual’s family~~, were.
