



**SENATE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 572**

March 27, 1996 - Offered by Senator HUELSMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 6: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 1m.** 111.335 (1) (cg) of the statutes is created to read:

4 111.335 (1) (cg) Notwithstanding s. 111.322, it is not employment
5 discrimination because of conviction record to refuse to employ, or to bar or terminate
6 from employment, any individual who has been convicted of any misdemeanor or
7 other offense that carries a penalty of less than 9 months in a county jail the
8 circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular
9 job.”.

10 **2.** Page 2, line 11: delete “, misdemeanor or other offense and” and substitute
11 “or of a misdemeanor that carries a penalty of 9 months or more in a county jail and
12 who”.
