## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 6, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 2

May 19, 1998 – Offered by Representatives Kunicki, Bock, Coggs, Cullen, Krug, Krusick, La Fave, Morris-Tatum, Notestein, Plale, R. Potter, Riley, Wasserman and L. Young.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 2, line 5: after that line insert the following material:
3	"SECTION 1m. 20.255 (2) (ed) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	20.255 (2) (ed) (title) Youth service centers, truancy Truancy abatement and
5	burglary suppression. The amounts in the schedule for youth service centers,
6	truancy abatement and burglary suppression under 1993 Wisconsin Act 16, section
7	<del>9145 (1t) (b) <u>s. 119.55 (3)</u>.</del> No moneys may be encumbered under this paragraph after
8	June 30, <del>1996</del> <u>2000</u> .".
9	2. Page 5, line 4: after that line insert the following material:
10	"SECTION 6. 119.55 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
11	119.55 (3) The board shall contract with the Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater
12	Milwaukee to provide case managers at selected middle schools and high schools to

work with school staff and pupils and their families to improve the attendance rate
of pupils enrolled in the selected schools. The board shall use the funds appropriated
under s. 20.255 (2) (ed) to pay the costs of the contracts. No contract under this
subsection may extend beyond June 30, 2000.".

**3.** Page 6, line 20: after that line insert the following material:

## **"SECTION 9239. Appropriation changes; public instruction.**

(1) TRUANCY ABATEMENT AND BURGLARY SUPPRESSION. In the schedule under
section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of public
instruction under section 20.005 (2) (ed) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of
10 1997, the dollar amount is increased by \$325,000 for fiscal year 1998–99 to increase
funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.".
