



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 493**

November 10, 1997 – Offered by Representative STEINBRINK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: delete that line and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 1g.** 943.50 (1) (ar), (as) and (at) of the statutes are created to read:

4 943.50 (1) (ar) “Theft detection device” means any tag or other device that is
5 used to prevent or detect theft and that is attached to merchandise held for resale
6 by a merchant or to property of a merchant.

7 (as) “Theft detection device remover” means any tool or device designed and
8 primarily intended for use in removing a theft detection device from merchandise
9 held for resale by a merchant or property of a merchant.

10 (at) “Theft detection shielding device” means any laminated or coated bag or
11 device designed to shield merchandise held for resale by a merchant or property of
12 a merchant from being detected by an electronic or magnetic theft alarm sensor.
