**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 327**

March 9, 2000 – Offered by Representative RILEY.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2           **1.** Page 1, line 3: delete the material beginning with “owners” and ending with  
3           “registration” on line 4 and substitute “owners to include their birth dates on  
4           applications for motor vehicle registration and forfeiture of vehicles involved in  
5           certain drug crimes”.

6           **2.** Page 1, line 5: delete that line and substitute:

7           “**SECTION 1.** 341.08 (1m) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act ....  
8           (Assembly Bill 315), is amended to read:

9           341.08 **(1m)** The forms for application for original registration and for renewal  
10          of registration under sub. (1) shall include the information required under s. 85.103  
11          (2) and the applicant’s birth date.”

12          **3.** Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 8.

13          **4.** Page 2, line 9: before that line insert:

1           “**SECTION 2.** 341.08 (2) (a) and (am) of the statutes are amended to read:

2           341.08 (2) (a) The name and birth date of the owner.

3           (am) If the owner under par. (a) is a lessee, the name and birth date of the  
4           lessor.”.

5           **5.** Page 2, line 14: delete lines 14 to 19 and substitute:

6           “**SECTION 3g.** 341.17 (9) (a) 3. of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act  
7           ... (Assembly Bill 315), is amended to read:

8           341.17 (9) (a) 3. “Personal identifier” has the meaning given in s. 85.103 (1) and  
9           includes a birth date submitted under s. 341.08.

10          **SECTION 3m.** 961.55 (1) (d) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

11          961.55 (1) (d) 2. No vehicle is subject to forfeiture under this section by reason  
12          of any act or omission established by the owner thereof to have been committed or  
13          omitted without the owner’s knowledge or consent. This subdivision does not apply  
14          to any vehicle owned by a person who is under 16 years of age on the date that the  
15          vehicle is used, or is intended for use, in the manner described under par. (d) (intro.),  
16          unless the court determines that the owner is an innocent bona fide owner;”.

17          **SECTION 5m. Initial applicability.**

18          (1) The treatment of section 961.55 (1) (d) 2. of the statutes first applies to  
19          vehicles used, or intended for use, on the effective date of this subsection in the  
20          manner described under section 961.55 (1) (d) 2. of the statutes.”.
