EXECUTIVE ORDER 7003

EXECUTIVE ORDER 7003

WHEREAS, The University of Wisconsin is proposing to purchase, for about \$4.5 million, the first unit of what could be a \$15 million computer capable of serving the research and instruction needs of the entire University system; and

WHEREAS, The computer could ultimately extend service to State Universities and provide some specialized services for Wisconsin business and industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WARREN P. KNOWLES, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby establish a Task Force on Computer Services, as a Staff Committee whose membership shall include Hal C. Kuehl, Chairman; Craig R. Conroy; George J. Hess; Wilmer C. Stach; Salvatore Toffanetti; Dr. Marvin S. Muller; Dr. William E. White; Dr. Robert H. DeZonia; Carl W. Vorlander; George C. Kaiser; and Charles A. Engman, Jr., for the purpose of reviewing the proposed purchase of the computer. This Executive Order to supersede the Executive Order issued February 15, 1967, establishing the Task Force on Computer Services.
